Our World

Spring 1

What we are up to this half term...

Our topic this half term is 'Under the Sea'

English

This half term we will be reading the story of 'Sally and the Limpet' and using this to inspire our story writing. We will have a focus on writing a narrative using descriptive vocabulary. We will also be going to Sea life aquarium to inspire our non-fiction writing about sea life and we will also be learning about the features of letter writing in order writing a letter of appreciation to the aquarium!

Maths

This term we will be building on our addition, subtraction, multiplication and division skills. The children will learn how to use jottings and empty numberlines to add/subtract 2 digit numbers with 2 digit numbers. We will be focusing on how to apply our maths skills to solve problems.

Science

In science we are learning about animals and their habitats. We will learn the different habitats animals live in and how they are suitable for their living environments. We will also be learning about animal food chains and are looking forward to watching a live penguin feed at the aquarium!

PE

This term Bluebell will have P.E. on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Daffodil class will have P.E on Wednesday and Thursday. All children need to have full P.E. kit to participate. Our P.E. uniform is white t-shirt, navy/black shorts and trainers or plimsolls.

Art and Design Technology

In art we will be looking at the famous artist George Seurat and creating a piece of artwork in a similar style. We will also be designing and making a 3D aquarium with floating fish!

RE

We will be looking at Islam this term. The children will learn about the main teachings of this religion and how we can show respect for other's beliefs.

Geography

The children will be learning about the surrounding seas of the United Kingdom using globes and atlases. We will also be learning and identifying the physical features of the seaside.

History

We will be learning about the significant event and famous 'Titanic'. Children will look at a simple timeline of the events and we will be looking at the famous seas the Titanic travelled through.
