

## Summer 2 – Home and School Learning Expectations

### Writing:

- *Home Learning*
  - Lessons based on a genre - two week focus for each genre
  - 4 Day lesson rotation (one day planning, two days drafting, one day revising and editing)
  - Provide generic (not individual) feedback for drafting on Tuesday or Wednesday to support children with redrafting and editing on Thursday
  - When teaching at school plan afternoon lessons on Tuesday and Wednesday accordingly to allow for time out of the class to provide feedback
- *School Learning*
  - Use same rotation of lessons for the children at school

### Reading (Y1 – Y6):

- *Home Learning*
  - Y1 question weekly (reminding children that they should be reading every day) on book the children have read using google classroom – direct children to the website below
  - 2 Comprehensions a week
  - Comment on one of the comprehensions
  - You could use the quiz function to create the comprehensions rather than a Google form
  - We are looking at using MyOn for digital books to support Accelerated Reader or another platform that will support home reading and comprehension. This will reduce workload.
- *School Learning*
  - Children in school should access MyOn reading using the iPads

### Phonics (Rec – Y2):

- *Home Learning*
  - 2 phonics lessons a week using Letters and Sounds videos
  - <https://www.wandleenglishhub.org.uk/lettersandsounds>
- *School Learning:*
  - Continue with 4 phonics lessons a week based on Letters and Sounds

### Maths:

- *Home Learning*
  - Mathematics two sessions per week for KS1, three sessions per week for KS2
  - Set one White Rose lesson a week or an investigation for the children
  - When possible, use White Rose teaching videos to support online learning
  - Mark and provide feedback at the end of the week.
- *School Learning*
  - In school, children can complete the investigation for one maths lesson
  - Use White Rose premium resources (worksheets and PowerPoint) for the additional four lessons during the week

### Humanities:

- *Home Learning*
  - Ask one question a week based on previous topics or concepts
  - Children comment on post and each other's ideas, teachers do not need to respond
- *School Learning*
  - Use afternoon lessons to deliver two humanities lessons a week

### PSHE:

- Home Learning
  - Andrew to post weekly question based on Picture News
- School Learning
  - 2 PSHE lessons a week to support social and emotional needs for the children
  - Use the first week back to develop routines and establish expectations for behaviour

### PE:

- Home Learning
  - Andrew to post 2 PE lessons a week using Joe Wicks
- School Learning
  - There will be a timetable for 1 session of outside PE each week. If there are open times available, teachers may schedule an additional PE lesson
